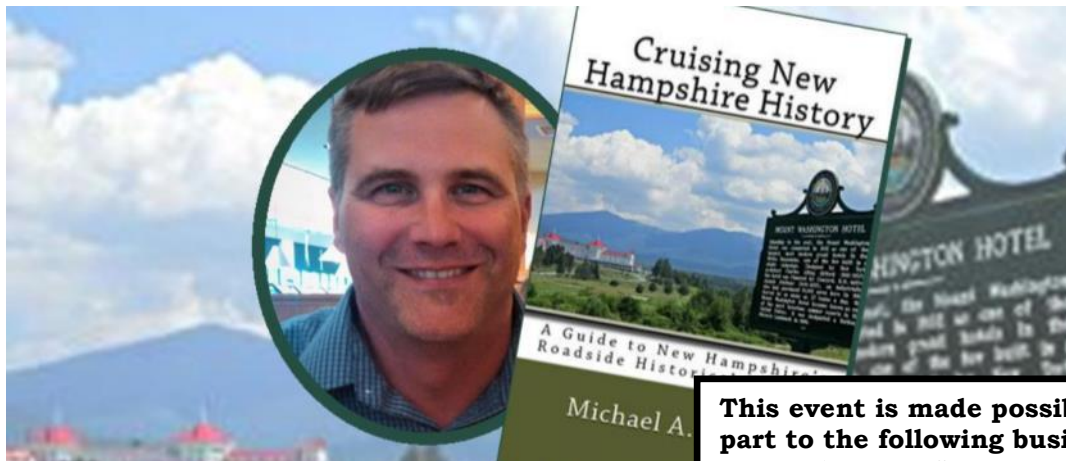
"Cruising NH Road Markers " **Presented by: Micheal Bruno**
