Taking his place to play the score for two Buster Keaton features, there's a reason accompanist Jeff Rapsis will have no sheet music on his keyboard. It's because he'll be making up the music right there on the spot.

And it won't be rinky-tink piano accompaniment. Rapsis, a New Hampshire-based musician and composer, will use a digital synthesizer to recreate the texture of the full orchestra, complete with pounding drums and clashing cymbals, all produced in real time by a traditional keyboard with 88 keys.
