Complications ensue, as only they can when Laurel and Hardy tackle a task. Length: 25 minutes.

Feature attraction: **'Paths to Paradise'** (1925) starring Raymond Griffith, Betty Compson. Two competing would-be jewel thieves reluctantly team up to pull off a major heist. Starring Raymond Griffith, a leading comedian for Paramount Pictures (and the only one with a New Hampshire connection) whose popularity rivaled Chaplin and Keaton in the 1920s, but who is forgotten today because most of his films are lost. Length: 65 minutes.

Jeff Raspsis will be taking his place to accompany the two features. There's a reason he will have no sheet music on his keyboard - it's because he'll be making up the music right there on the spot. And it won't be rinky-tink piano accompaniment. Raspsis, a New Hampshire-based musician and composer, will use a digital synthesizer to recreate the texture of the full orchestra, complete with pounding drums and clashing cymbals, all produced in real time by a traditional keyboard with 88 keys.
