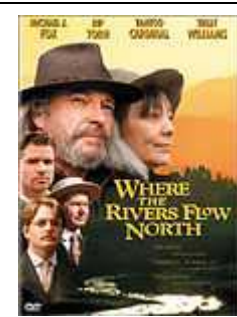
Where the Rivers Flow North (1993) PG-13

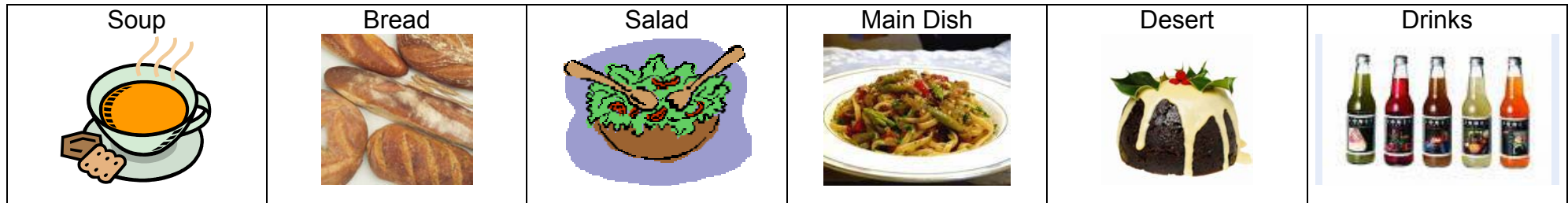
