## **“The Reuse of Old Buildings”**

Alex Ray has a long history of rehabilitating old buildings. Since 1971 he has converted many old buildings into restaurants, old mills into inns and restored the local movie theatre in Plymouth to become the Flying Monkey Movie House & Performance Center. He also renovated the historic Daniel Webster homestead in Franklin, NH, preserving the historic structures and converting them into a non-profit drug and alcohol rehabilitation center called Webster Place Center. During this program Alex will talk about his experiences and reasons for preserving old buildings.

Alex Ray is the owner and founder of The Common Man Family of Restaurants, and is known just as much for his family-style restaurants across New Hampshire as he is for his tireless philanthropic work in communities across the state.
