"Tracking Ospreys from New Hampshire to South America"

Presented by: Iain MacLeod

Iain MacLeod will describe Project OspreyTrack, a multi-year project using GPS trackers to follow Ospreys from their nests in New Hampshire to their wintering grounds in South America. MacLeod is also learning much about the foraging behaviors of breeding male Ospreys. Hear the amazing and sometimes tragic stories of 15 NH Ospreys, including Art, a male Osprey from a nest in Bridgewater who travelled 5,000 miles to his winter home in Brazil and returned to his nest in April 2013 to be greeted by a film crew and reporters. In 2016, 6 Ospreys from Newfoundland were added to the project and Iain will describe their amazing journeys.

MacLeod is Executive Director of the Squam Lakes Natural Science Center in Holderness. He was with NH Audubon for 18 years. Iain has studied Ospreys in New Hampshire for more than 30 years and is a member of the *New Hampshire Bird Records* Editorial Team and the New Hampshire Rare Birds Committee.
