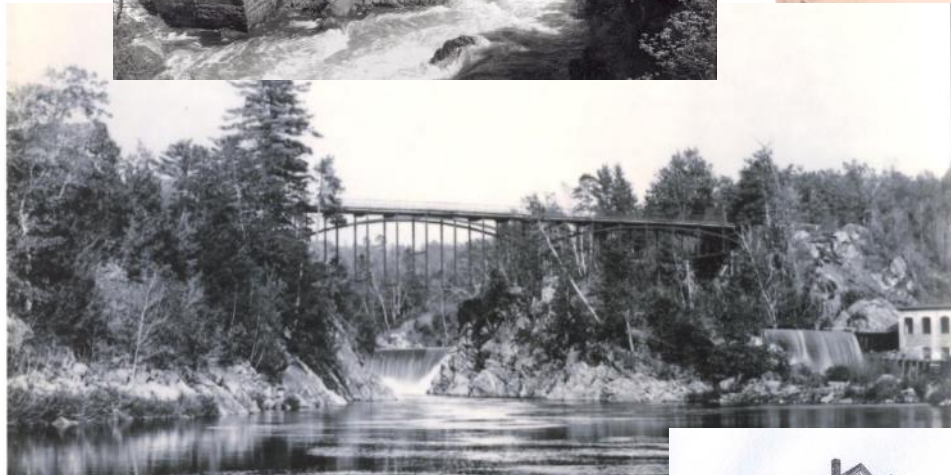

"Livermore Hollow: Centuries of Work on the Pemi "

Presented by: David Trubey

This presentation will highlight the archaeological record of the Hollow from its earliest use by Native Americans through its industrial days to its present use as a state recreation area.

David has been working as an archaeologist for the past twenty years in both the private and public sectors. He began his career as a marine archaeologist along the southeastern coast before transitioning to dry land. He is currently an archaeologist with the New Hampshire Division of Historical Resources, which offers archaeological training through its State Conservation and Rescue Archaeology Program (SCRAP) at various locations throughout New Hampshire.
