**“The Geology of Campton”**  
**Presented by: Bryon Middlekauf**

Central New Hampshire in general and Campton in particular, with its varied landscapes, owes the look of their topography to the interaction of geologic and land forming processes. Mountain building, volcanism, glacial erosion and deposition, and stream erosion and deposition combined to form the terrain here. This illustrated presentation will recount the long and varied history of landscape evolution for our area. There will be a special emphasis on the rock called Camptonite, named for our Town.



The presentation will be offered by Bryon Middlekauff, Professor of Geography and Environmental Science and Planning at Plymouth State University. Middlekauff is a 22 year resident of Campton.
