"E. Dole & Co. Woolen Mill Restoration"

The E. Dole & Co Woolen Mill was operated continuously in Campton from 1826 to 1952 by the Dole family. Operations ceased in 1965 and the "Dole mill" sat, for the most part, vacant and neglected for 52 years. The building was purchased by Sky and Jessica Bartlett in 2017 and is now fully renovated into a multi-use space. The building is, for the first time in over 52 years, turning a small profit.

Sky Bartlett grew up in Lincoln NH. His background is in construction and mechanical work. His father and both grandfathers worked in the Lincoln papermill throughout the 20th century. Industrial history, always having been an interest, compelled him and his wife to purchase and restore the E. Dole & Co woolen mill building in downtown Campton.
