"Campton's Three Historic Covered Bridges"

Kim Varney Chandler, author of *Covered Bridges of New Hampshire* (Coming early fall 2022) will present on Campton's three historic covered bridges: Blair, Bump and Turkey Jim's.

Covered Bridges of New Hampshire features historical narratives of New Hampshire's historic covered bridges that are supported with primary sources gained from partnerships with National Society for the Preservation of Covered Bridges, bridgewrights, timber framers, bridge engineers, historical societies, town offices, libraries, state organizations, and community members. Campton is fortunate to have three historic covered bridges; each with their own story to tell!

Kim Varney Chandler is a natural researcher, amateur genealogist, photographer, bird watcher, and dog lover. She is a two-time graduate of the University of New Hampshire ('91, '96G) where her love of history began in Professor Charles Clark's classroom in Horton Hall.
