## "The Pemigewasset Valley: A History"


Presented by: Daniel Heyduk

Local author Daniel Heyduk,- who has written the books Meredith Chronicles, Stories in the History of New Hampshire's Lakes Region, and The Story of Franconia Notch – will make a presentation based on his book The Pemigewasset Valley: A History. This is the first book to cover the entire valley, with its farms, scenery, industries, log drives, covered bridges, railroads, hotels, storms, floods, and more.

Campton, Plymouth and their surroundings played an important part in many episodes of the valley's history, and sometimes in stark contrast to other towns.

As a local historian, Heyduk worked with historical societies, libraries, and museums from Franklin to Bethlehem in order to gather material for the book. He included much history written by the valley's own people, and many historic photographs are in the book and in his presentation.


Now retired, Dan Heyduk did anthropological and archaeological research in South America, was a college professor, and ran educational programs worldwide, before settling in New Hampshire.
