## **Beebe River From Settlers To Trout Conservation**

One thing that piqued his interest was a meeting where The Conservation Fund described their plans for a property in Campton and Sandwich that included a long stretch of the Beebe River. His presentation will be about the early history of the area; changes to populations and land usage over decades; and recent changes since the Beebe property conversion to conservation – much of the latter relates to Eastern Brook Trout.
