What led to the decline and eventual demise of this once thriving village, now known only as a favorite swimming hole. Nadine Miller, the NH Deputy State Historical Preservation Officer, will share stories and discoveries about the town that once existed along the Pemi at the junction of Plymouth, Campton, and Holderness.
