LOCATION: 180 Beech Hill Road, Wentworth, NH. Beech Hill Road is off the left of route 25 (about .6 miles north of where 25A splits off). The nursery is 1 mile up Beech Hill Road on the right. Pull all the way up to the canopy. If you are late, head for the torri gate.
