Polar Caves Park – Ice Age to Attraction

Karen will discuss the geological origins, human stories, and transformation of Polar Caves Park, then briefly share how that same landscape inspired her fantasy novellas *Babbling Brook Society*, set at Polar Caves Park, and the forthcoming *Waterfall Down Lodge*, set at Quincy Bog. Blending local history with creative insight, this talk offers a fascinating look at how real places shape both the past we preserve and the stories we imagine.
